



## Workshop/field trip proposals

Through support from the Joint Fire Science Program, the consortium can fund 2-3 workshops/field trips per year at a rate of up to \$8,000 per workshop or field trip. These should target specific topics and may focus on sub-regions within the consortium. The available funds can be used for activities such as logistical support, room rental, food, and travel. Travel funds can be used for vehicle rental and gas for field trips or to support individuals who would like to travel to attend the workshop or field trip. The consortium can also provide logistical support for planning and/or facilitating the activity. The consortium will accept proposals to support planned activities or development of new workshops or field trips. Proposals for a workshop or field trip should follow the following format.

### *Title*

### *Description of proposed workshop or field trip (2 page limit)*

Include information on the purpose and need for the workshop/field trip and planned activities.

### *Time frame (1 paragraph limit)*

Include when the proposed activity would take place and the time needed for planning.

### *Budget (1 page limit)*

Include amount of funds requested (up to \$8,000) and what funds would be used for. Also include any matching funds.

### *Contact Information*

Include name, title, affiliation, address, phone, fax and email.
